Tundraising, Investing in PR

- Another year of strong fundraising, as well as a commitment to lower the fund balance to \$15,000, resulted in another year of significant spending for the PR Staff.
- We have continued to purchase books for the school with all of the proceeds from our Book Fairs, as well as with some of the fundraising money (\$4,000 over the past 2 years).
- Over the past 3 years, the PR PTA has invested heavily in technology, purchasing almost 100 iPads, 50 Chromebooks, an Apple TV, and 5 Smart Boards.
- We also invested in our teachers by renovating the teacher lounge into a more comfortable, welcoming, collaborative space.
