

The 2025-2026 Pleasant Ridge PTA is proud to introduce this year's funding opportunities for Pleasant Ridge Staff to enhance the educational experiences of their students.

Room Parent Allowance

- Room Parent/Caregiver are allocated up to **\$100** per class to spend on supplies for class parties.
- To get reimbursed, turn in receipt(s) along with the attached reimbursement form to the PTA Treasurer box in the office or email the form and receipt to treasurer@prpta.org.
- Receipts are required to receive reimbursement.
- **Requests for reimbursements are due by May 15, 2026.**

Classroom Supply Allowance

We recognize the amount of money you personally use for supplies for your classroom. We have therefore allocated **\$125** for each of the Classrooms (20), Specials (5), and Additional Certified/Support Staff (11) to use on supplies and tools for the classroom.

- To get reimbursed, simply turn in your receipt along with the attached reimbursement form to the PTA Treasurer box in the office or email the form and receipt to treasurer@prpta.org.
- Our Treasurer will keep track of your spending and reimburse up to \$125.
- **Requests for reimbursements must be made no later than January 5, 2026.**

Curriculum Donations

- The PTA has allocated **\$200** for each grade level (Y5-3rd) and each of the specials.
- Purchases must be curriculum related.
- To get reimbursed, turn in your receipts along with the attached reimbursement form to the PTA Treasurer box in the office or email the form and receipt to treasurer@prpta.org.
- **Requests for reimbursements must be made no later than January 5, 2026.**

Staff Mini-Grants

- The PTA will use a Mini-Grant Proposal Process to help with the planning and equitable distribution of funds.
- The total budget for this program is **\$1,500**, with a maximum amount of **\$300** per request.
- The PTA Executive Board and School Principal will review grant proposals throughout the year and will consider as funding allows.
- All requests must be submitted using the attached form. All requests must be signed by the principal.
- Please submit the form to the PTA President box in the office or email president@prpta.org.
- Grant funding Priorities:
 - 1) Projects that reach the greatest number of students.
 - 2) Projects that involve purchasing materials that are reusable and support curriculum objectives.
 - 3) Speakers, programs, projects that enrich curriculum objectives (beyond budgeted field trips and assemblies).
- **Grant Application Deadline: April 1, 2026.**

School Strategic Grants

- With the successful Fall fundraiser, we plan to be in a position to enable major investments for the school. These grants are intended to make an impact at the total school level. Past items have included playground equipment, media center supplies, swings, cafeteria sound system, mini iPads, smart boards, Literacy Library books, and a die cut machine.
- The PTA Executive Board will review proposals from the School Principal and/or the Teacher Representative which should represent recommendations from the staff as a whole.
- Ideas for Strategic Grants should be brought to the attention of the Principal and/or the Teacher Representative.
